 - 501c3 pays mortgage
 - Current leases continue property taxes will need to be paid
 - New 501c3 receives income from property and pays mortgage
 - Building will be protected from school district if purchased through new 501c3
 - Able to attend June Board Meeting
 - Consulting is free
 - If more extensive work needed possible low fee
